Lesson Outline		
Phase of the lesson	Duration	Description
Warm-up	5 min	Ask children about the fruits and vegetables they know. Then, say the name in English. Later, you can use these vegetables, but in English.
	5 min	Enter in a real on-line vegetables shop and try to identify all. For example: https://fruterias-labotiga.com/en/online-shop/buy-fruit-online/ In this Kind of webpages, you can select idioms.
Main activity	10 min	https://wordwall.net/es/resource/56989105 Children have to pair the photo of the fruit or vegetable with the name in English. It is the same activity that they perform in their own language to be easier to understand.
	20 min	Use Google translator https://translate.google.com/ to translate fruits and vegetables. Let them write their favourite vegetable and listen and read the word in English.
	10 min	Using ChatGPT, you can ask it something like this: "Now you are a 5-year- old child that wants to talk about my favourite vegetables." or "You have to correct my English in the following prompts" and then start talking with it. Let's ask whatever they want and then read and explain the result.
	10 min	Ask ChatGPT for a poem about some fruit in English. Then let's read it or copy the poem to google translator to listen to it.
Assessment	5 min	Ask the children for random fruits and vegetables names they know in English.
	5 min	Check the auto evaluation the platform do.
