Main activity	30	Do the activities of this web page: https://learnenglishkids.britishcouncil.org/listen-watch/songs/way The teacher has to help children in order to read and complete the activities well.			
	10	Write the lyrics of the song in a word document or similar with autocorrection *.			
	30	Ask them to interact in English in assembly talking about routines. Try to sing parts of the song during the assembly.			
Assessment	5	See the results of the individual activity related to the song			
	5	Talk about the new words and observe the children's interaction in English.
