Main activity	10	Talk in assembly about the topic and about the activity: Create a poster about the environment and our feelings for the negative impact of the humans in it.
	20	Present the canva tool: https://www.canva.com/ and decide the template to use and the main topics they want to express.
	30	Make a poster for an A3 format. They have to use the computer by turns and select a negative or positive photo and select the appropriate emoji for the photo.
