

Phase of the lesson	Duration	Description
Warm-up	10 min	<p>Gul sort my garbage according to its categories.            How do you dispose of your garbage?            Do you have boxes where you collect them separately?            I brought you a video about recycling. Let's watch.  <a href="https://youtu.be/6jQ7y_qQYUA">https://youtu.be/6jQ7y_qQYUA</a></p>
Main activity	10 min	<p>Now we will play a game about recycling. Let's put our waste in the appropriate recycling bin. Let's think hard!</p> <p>While playing the game, ask the children: "What other materials can we throw in the recycling bins?" Think about the things you throw away at home. What are the things you should recycle from them?  <a href="https://wordwall.net/tr/resource/8735620">https://wordwall.net/tr/resource/8735620</a></p>
	15 min	<p>The teacher asks some questions:</p> <p>What will happen if we do not separate our waste?            What does our environment look like?            How is the environment affected?            What affects our environment?            Do you think animals will be harmed?</p> <p>After getting the answers, the teacher shows the children the following video.  <a href="https://youtu.be/OasbYWF4_S8">https://youtu.be/OasbYWF4_S8</a></p>
	10 min	<p>Kids, we watched the video. What do you think? What happens if we don't recycle waste? What do you think after the video?</p> <p>Now, everyone should draw on paper what our environment will look like if we do not separate our waste and send it for recycling.</p> <p>Then the pictures they made can be turned into an online booklet and sent to families. They are asked to review the booklet and think of solutions together at home.</p>



<b>Assessment</b>	5 min	The teacher encourages the children to talk about the pictures they have made. They show and tell their pictures to each other.  A short discussion is held with the children about what will happen if we do not separate our waste and make it suitable for recycling.
