

Lesson phase	Duration	Description

	10 minutes	To raise children's awareness of having correct attitudes and taking care of our planet, I proposed a short story

Principal activity	15 minutes	Brainstorming to explore children's pre-knowledge about separate waste collection by watching a story. Collective verbal reworking guided by the teacher. https://youtu.be/agzePoVUnDY?si=SfyCE8M7lfsQLz3u
	20 minutes	Let's find a black bag in the classroom where there are many empty containers: plastic bottles, yoghurt pots, glass bottles, cardboard boxes, etc. We invite the children, taking their turn, to remove them from the bag and name them. and to divide them based on the material. We present the children with containers of different colors and ask them to put the objects in the right container.
