Lesson Outline		
Phase of the lesson	Duration	Description
Warm-up	5 min	<p>Who does sports? I exercise to be healthy. S Why are you doing sports? Let's examine sports branches together. https://youtu.be/11e9IzV2cCQ</p>
Main activity	10 min	<p>Let's play a game about sports. Look at the cards on the screen, I will shuffle the cards and open them one by one. One of you will explain the sports branch on each card opened. So let's start. https://wordwall.net/tr/resource/58559597 Which sport did you like the most? What sports do you know other than the ones in the picture? What sports would you like to do? Who wants to be an athlete?</p>
	10 min	<p>Afterwards, a rhythm game is played with the children. Children spell out the names of the sports they see on the cards and find a rhythm for them. For example tennis: te; hits the index once – nis; claps hands once. In this way, everyone finds the rhythm and repeats it with the person who made it.</p>
	10 min	<p>To make the activities more fun, the teacher plays a matching game. Children match the visuals of sports on the screen with the equipment used. https://wordwall.net/tr/resource/58559755</p>
Assessment	10 min	<p>The teacher talks to the children about sports. Is there a sport you want to do? Why? What are the effects of doing sports on our health? Children playing sports introduce the equipment they use to their friends by showing them on the screen.</p>
