

<b>Age group</b>	6 years old
<b>Main topic</b>	To develop children's ability to hear and understand the read text while performing tasks and to retell the heard piece while acting.

Lesson Outline		
Phase of the lesson	Duration	Description
Warm-up	5 min	Children are asked to imagine that they are in a spaceship and are about to fly to their home planet "Earth". They are asked what they can see in space (brainstorming). The teacher tells that today they all will listen to a story about the Earth, the Moon and the Sun, showing the figures intended for acting. The tasks of this lesson are presented.
	4 min	<p>Children are invited to listen to the video of the story "Sun and Moon" <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TtIjrccmXNM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TtIjrccmXNM</a></p> <p><i>The story "Sun and Moon" in english language</i></p> <p><i>"Long long ago, when there were no people, there was a Moon and a Sun. They lived in a bright castle and loved each other very much. And they had a beautiful daughter. They gave their daughter the name Earth.</i></p> <p><i>For many years the Moon and the Sun lived beautifully, but one day they got angry.</i></p> <p><i>- You are so hot that I cannot live with you," says the Moon. - If you don't change your ways, I will leave you.</i></p> <p><i>- And you are as cold as ice. If you keep it up, we can't live together.</i></p> <p><i>- We can separate," said the Moon angrily, "but my daughter will stay with me.</i></p> <p><i>- No, I will not leave my daughter to you. She cannot live with such a cold man.</i></p> <p><i>They argued for a long time and there was no end in sight. Finally, they decided to ask Thunder to find the right solution.</i></p> <p><i>He listened to the Sun and the Moon and said, "You both are talking nonsense. But if you want to divorce so divorce. Only your daughter Earth cannot belong to either of you, so it will be like this: The Sun will protect your daughter during the day and the Moon at night.</i></p> <p><i>They both know that the decision of Thunder is right and they carry it out sacredly: from morning to evening the Sun watches over their daughter Earth, and from evening to morning the Moon protects her. When the Moon is away, the Earth is looked after by its sister stars."</i></p>
	10 min	<p>The story is discussed while playing "Wordwall" games "Sun and Moon. What do you remember?" <a href="https://wordwall.net/resource/60923425">https://wordwall.net/resource/60923425</a> and "Sun and Moon. Who said what?" <a href="https://wordwall.net/resource/60923223">https://wordwall.net/resource/60923223</a></p>
	5 min	<p>An active game "Day and Night" is played. The teacher explains the rules of the game. One player must be the leader. When he says "day" the game players move safely in the intended environment, and when he says "night" the game players freeze and do not move. If someone moves, they are out of the game or have to switch places with the leader.</p> <p>It is discussed that during the day, when it is light, our planet Earth</p>



		is protected by the Sun, and during the night, when it is dark, the Earth is protected by the Moon.
	10 min	Children act out the fairy tale "The Sun and the Moon". The play requires 7 actors (Sun, Moon, Earth, Thunder and 3 Stars) and 1 Narrator. Other children can be spectators. Using figures of the fairy tale characters, children will remember the plot of the story, try to remember and repeat the words of the characters while playing. Let the children choose the characters they want.
	5 min	Discuss with the children what was difficult, what they liked, what they did not like. Children's reflections on the lesson using the Emoticons evaluation tool (Children evaluate their participation in the lesson and rate the lesson using an emoticon: happy-great, sad-I am unhappy, or lipless-I am indecisive).
<b>Assessment</b>	5 min	Children watched the fairy tale "The Sun and the Moon", understood the text they heard, answered the questions asked. Actively engaged in the active game "Day and Night". Associated it with the role of the Sun and the Moon to protect the Earth. While acting, they remembered and retold the text they heard.
