Lesson Outline		
Phase of the lesson	Duration	Description
Warm-up	5 min	Ask children about the fruits and vegetables they know. Write the name on the computer and search in google images some photos.
	5 min	Enter in a real on-line vegetables shop and try to identify all. For example: https://fruterias-labotiga.com/en/online-shop/buy-fruit-online/



Main activity	10 min	Let's talk about the name of fruits and vegetables: https://wordwall.net/es/resource/56989105 Children have to pair the photo of the fruit or vegetable with the name.
	10 min	Ask children some questions: Did you see a coconut palm in your town? Which plants grow in our country? https://wordwall.net/es/resource/56989414 Spin the wheel and say if the fruit or vegetable is from our country. Do you remember the name?
	10 min	Invite the children to take for lunch the most rare fruit or vegetable from their home. Then, talk about it and search with "Google Lens" with a mobile phone or tablet if it can identify them.
	10 min	Ask children if they can eat oranges in summer. Many fruits and vegetables are not available all the days of the year. This blog shows us a chart about fruits and seasons. children can see it and make a list of fruits available when the activity is done: https://www.berries.com/blog/what-fruits-are-in-season
Assessment	5 min	The wordWall activities are auto evaluated. children can see if they have done the activity well.
	5 min	Discuss in group about the conclusions they have reached about fruits, vegetables and seasonality.
